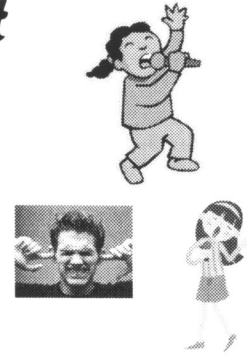
- (noun)

evasive

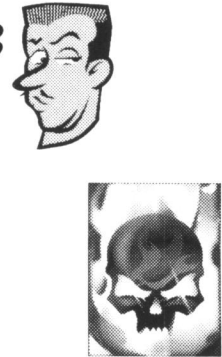
- (adjective)

insidious

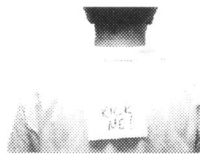
- (adjective)

irreverent

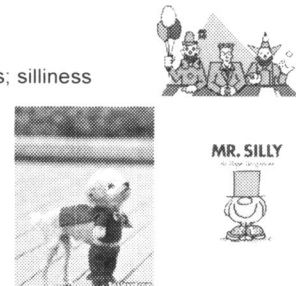
- (adjective)
